We are thankful for the Grand Opening of Graceway Baptist Church in Footscray, VIC! Several churches came to help us distribute thousands of John and Romans booklets and invitations as well as support our opening services. Our community night saw **six visitors** from the community. Our music concert was packed with at least **seven visitors**, and our opening services were well attended with 48 in the morning and 50+ in the evening.



Last Sunday, we had a Fijian family visit Graceway who knew some of the pastors and kids in Fiji where we had just been a week before. What a small world!
